Alaska Inside Passage

A long time ago, southbound glaciers carved out the Inside Passage, leaving majestic fjords, islands and bays in their wake. Today, the spectacular views will leave a lasting impression on you. From the lush greenery of Tongass National Forest - the world's largest and northernmost temperate coastal rainforest - to the brilliant blue glaciers, you'll see jawdropping beauty everywhere you look.

Juneau

Juneau, the capital of Alaska, was founded during a gold rush in 1880. Today, the former gold-mining town counts among its riches some of Alaska's most spectacular scenery. Nestled at the foot of Mt. Juneau in the Alaska Panhandle, it faces the water from the mainland side of Gastineau Channel. Several magnificent fjords are located along the channel coast, and the majestic Mendenhall Glacier, a favorite of visitors, is nearby. Optional Whale Watch in Juneau: Join folks from Sail & Sing Christian cruise for our exclusively chartered Whale Watch & Wildlife Excursion. Onboard our whale watching boat, we'll set sail in search of Humpback and killer whales, sea lions and more! Skagway

When gold was discovered in the Klondike region of the Yukon Territory (just across the border from Alaska), it resulted in the historic Gold Rush of 1898. As thousands of goldcrazed adventurers sought the best starting point for their arduous trek, they found the deepest penetration possible by boat was at the northern tip of the Lynn Canal. This is how Skagway was born. While here, you can visit the beautiful waterfalls, walk to the miners graveyard from a century ago, or take a ride in the famous White Pass & Yukon Railroad. Optional Sail & Sing WP&Y Railroad tour through tunnels, over trestles, and cascading waterfalls. Excursion 3-3.5 hrs. \$129pp

Cruise Tracy Arm Fjord

Nestled between 3,000-foot high granite walls, the narrow, twisting slice of ocean called Tracy Arm Fjord weaves through the Tongass National Forest for roughly 35 miles. The shoreline is spotted with waterfalls created by melting snowcaps and trees sprouting at odd angles from rocky outcroppings. You will have ample time to admire the landscape and perhaps catch sight of a few native animals as you cruise through this fjord.

Victoria, British Columbia
